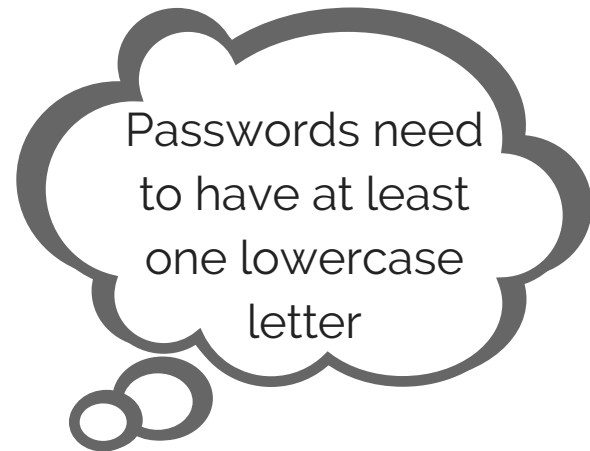

To make passwords harder to guess, you can add symbols

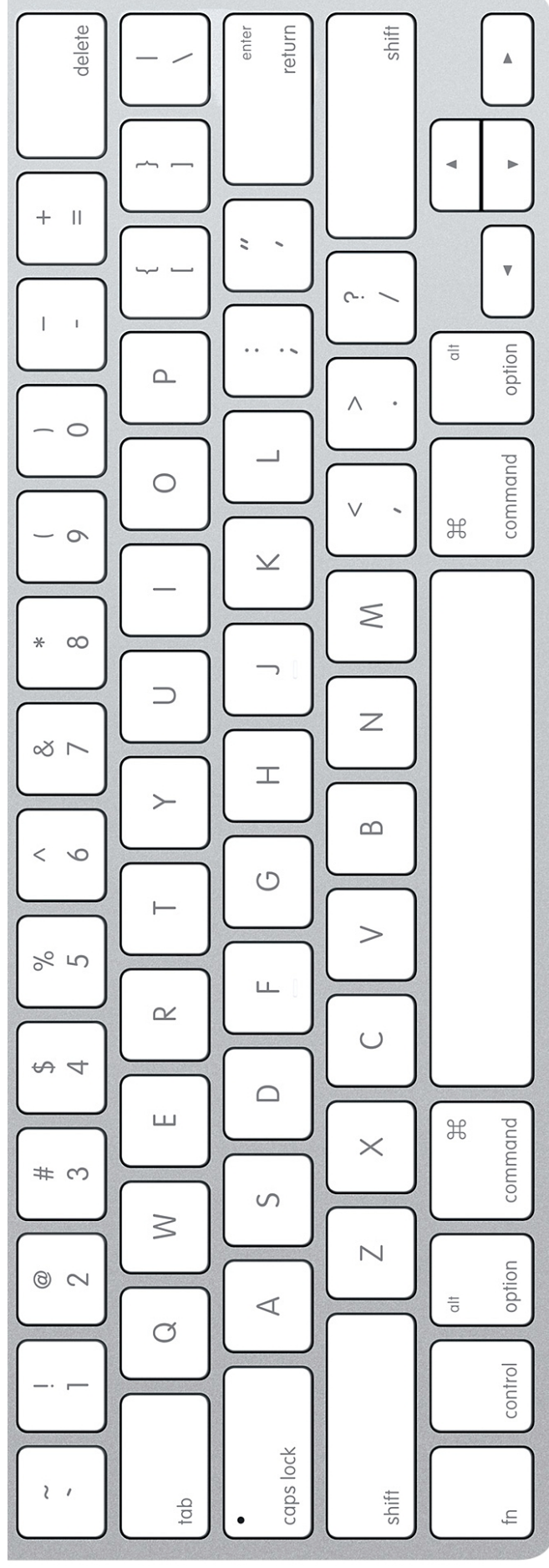
